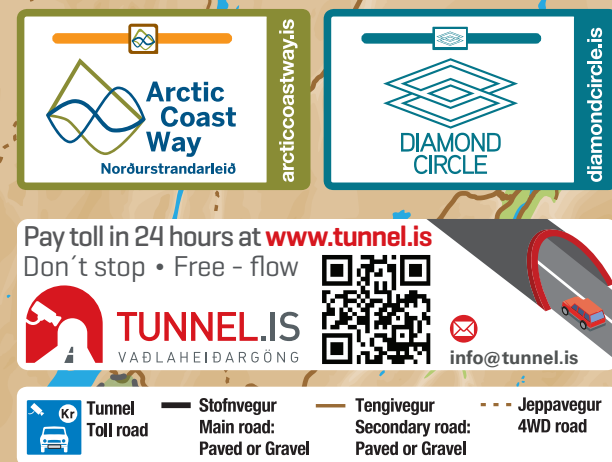
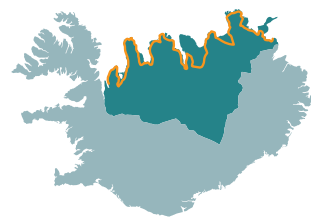

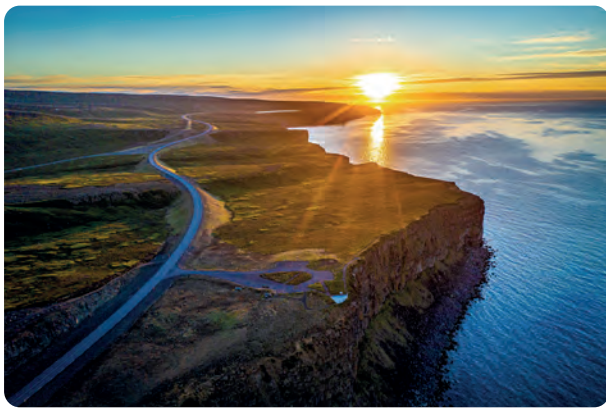
Arctic Coast Way

Five key destinations

The Diamond Circle is a magnificent circuit of 250km in North Iceland, which includes some of the most stunning sights and spots for unearthly landscapes.

The Diamond Circle has five key destinations, which include the historical and picturesque **Goðafoss**, the unearthly blue and green landscapes of **Lake Mývatn** nature paradise, the uncontrollable white energy of **Dettifoss**, the most powerful waterfall of Europe, the crescent-shaped wonder of **Ásbyrgi** canyon and **Húsavík** the buzzing whale watching capital of Iceland with the deep blue seas ahead.

The Diamond Circle offers even more. Discover the astonishing valley of Vesturdalur with the bizarre rock formations of Hljóðaklettur; the otherworldly volcanic fields of Krafla, the geothermal area of Hverir and the black lava formation at Dimmuborgir.
